Video Borrowing Rules

- Entertainment-style movies may be kept for 3 days with one renewal for an additional 3 days. Nonfiction movies may be borrowed for 3 weeks and renewed for an additional 3 weeks. Renewals may be made by calling the library at **312-5679 or 312-5682**.
- There is no charge for borrowing movies, but late returns are fined \$2.00 per day per item (maximum fine \$10.00 per item). **ALL ITEMS MUST BE RETURNED BY CLOSING TIME ON THE DATE THEY ARE DUE.**
- Movies must be returned to New Fairfield library only. All items may be returned in the outside bookdrop.
- Please rewind videos after viewing.
- There are no reserves allowed on movies.
- Borrowers under 18 years old must have parental permission on file to borrow movies.
- Excessive COLD or HEAT will damage tapes. Let cold videos reach room temperature before playing. Do NOT put videos on or near any appliances or recording equipment (magnetic field will erase the tape).
- **Handle DVDs with care.**
- The Borrower is responsible for any damage to items. The Library is NOT responsible for damage to borrower's equipment caused by library videos.

Borrowing privileges may be revoked if these rules are abused.
